

## **Involvement Levels for the Southcentral Wisconsin CISMA**

### **Council Member**

Involvement for time commitment and position duties described in the Position Description for a Council Member.

### **Individual Project Lead**

This level of involvement is less formal in that it does not require the individual to sit on the Council. A project lead is invited to attend Council meetings, but voting will be conserved for Council members. A project lead could be a Council member, a staffer at a nonprofit or government organization, or a citizen.

### **Individual Projects Participants**

This level of involvement is the most informal as the only prerequisite is to attend a workday sponsored by the CISMA. Anyone is welcome to attend.

### **Organizational Involvement | Formal**

An organization that has signed a copy of the memorandum of understanding (MOU) as written and approved by the Council is acknowledged as a formal participant. Participation does not require monetary or staff resources from the participating organization. By signing the MOU, the participating organization is stating the following: the organization understands and supports the work furthered by the CISMA; the organization will work with the CISMA to grant permission for work on lands managed by them.

### **Organizational Involvement | Informal**

An organization that is supporting the CISMA informally has no required participation duties. The organization receives newsletters and other communications; the organization can attend Council meetings as an informal participant; the organization assists with building the CISMA network through word-of-mouth and social media interactions.
